MISSION:

To help individuals of all ages achieve the skills necessary to draw realistically, and to teach the techniques necessary to gain confidence as an artist in other media, while encouraging creativity and independence.

CURRICULUM NOTES:

- Minimum recommended age for *Pre-Kindergarten Drawing* classes is 4½ years old, but we will accept mature 4-year-olds.
- All *kindergarten* and *elementary-aged* students are required to take beginner and intermediate drawing classes as a prerequisite to all other classes. Skills learned in these foundation classes are essential to the ARTSPLACE program:
 - **Beginner:** Curriculum includes contour line, flat color, texture, mirror image, negative space and volume drawing. Materials are Flair pens and markers.
 - **Intermediate I:** Reinforces beginner concepts with more detailed projects. (*Prerequisite: Beginner*)
 - **Intermediate II:** Introduces shading & volume drawing. (*Prerequisite: Intermediate I*)
 - **Advanced:** Includes perspective & introduces different media. (*Prerequisite: Intermediate II*)
- *Teens and adults* are encouraged to take drawing classes as needed to ensure success in other media.

REGISTRATION & REFUND POLICIES

- **Effective Fall 2009, full payment must accompany registration forms. We can provide class information by telephone, but you are not enrolled in a class until payment is received. This policy applies to ALL students. Please make sure that all appropriate registration and/or non-resident fees are included in your payment.**
- All classes/workshops have a minimum number of enrollees needed for the course to run. If this minimum is not met, then the class will be cancelled. For this reason, it is very important that you register for a program at least 2 weeks prior to the start date. If a class/workshop is cancelled, all registrants will be notified by telephone at least 3 days prior to the program start date.
- No news is good news! If you have not heard from us, you will be expected at class at the prescribed day and time.
- Unless otherwise noted, classes are held for 7-week sessions.
- Unless otherwise noted, all **standard** supplies are included; students must provide any “**premium**” supplies desired (e.g., oversized canvases), “**personal choice**” items (e.g., fabric/materials for quilting class), or materials for more than 1-2 projects (e.g., wool for felting).
- Artsplace follows the Cheshire Public Schools holiday schedule, unless otherwise noted. (*See <http://www.cheshire.k12.ct.us/aboutcps/calendar.html> for 2009-10 CPS school calendar.*)
- Full refunds will be given **only** if an art class or workshop is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment. **Credit** for art class, less a \$15 administration fee, will be given **if** notification is received **1 week prior** to the start of the program **and** your vacancy is filled.
- Once a class has begun, credit/refunds will not be given. **Careful consideration should be given prior to registration for any class or workshop.** Any exceptions from this policy will only be considered after the director reviews your written request.
- When bad weather cancels a class, or a teacher is ill, another class will be added to the end of the schedule. We regret that we are unable to offer make-up classes for student absences.

Pre-K

Mom & Tot

A mix of 2-D and 3-D projects including painting, collage, and clay.

Pre-Kindergarten Drawing/Art Fun (Ages 4–5)

Learn the basics of drawing with fun fine-motor projects.

Specialty Classes (Grades 1-8)

3-Dimensional Mixed Media (Grs. 2–4)

Inspired by Alexander Calder, make magical mobiles and other 3-dimensional art by incorporating found and recycled objects, including personal pieces from home.

“Figures in Motion”/Advanced Dwg. (Gr. 3-6)

Using pencils and charcoal, create gesture drawings full of movement and life.

Mixed Media Museum Style (Grs. 3–5)

Learn about the Wadsworth Atheneum collection of art as you explore styles, artists and artwork currently on display.

Painting Fun (Grs. 2–4)

Explore tempera, watercolor, and acrylics as you learn to paint.

Teens Only

Art/Architecture College Preparation (Grs. 9–12)

In this 8-week class, learn about the unexpected prerequisites for these majors as you strengthen your drawing skills and develop a suitable portfolio to prepare for a possible career in art or architecture.

Mixed Media Museum Style (Grs. 7–9)

Using the famous Wadsworth Atheneum Museum art collection as inspiration, students will create artwork exploring those styles and artists. Instructor is a staff member of the Hartford museum and is delighted to share her knowledge.

Teen Art (Grs. 7-9)

Enjoy the satisfaction of achieving realistic drawing. Once you know the tips and techniques taught in this class, you'll build a foundation of understanding and drawing will become easy.

Teens/Adults

Art Quilt Techniques (Adults)

Try a variety of techniques used by fine art quilters and reinforce composition and color choices. Student must bring a sewing machine with free-motion foot. *Additional supply list distributed upon registration.*

Basic Digital Photography and Critique (Teens/Adults)

In this 8-week class, spend the first 4 weeks on a basic overview of your digital camera with “special functions” explained (bring your manual). During the last 4 weeks, you will receive assignments and critique to improve your skills and techniques.

Batik (Teens/Adults)

Experience the magic of creating permanent art on fabric with beautiful dyes. Create a wall hanging by layering dyes and waxes to create surprising and unpredictable color explosions.

Drawing, Painting, & Collage (Adults)

In this 8-week class, beginner to advanced students can choose to work in either oil or acrylic paint with instruction in subject matter of choice.

Felted Folk! (Adults)

Using easy felting techniques including both wet felting and needle felting, students will create a 14”-16” character doll. Possibilities are endless and suggestions include St. Nicholas, wizard, or folk tale character.

Foundation Series (Teens/Adults):

Figures: Working from photos, students will learn to draw body proportions correctly in charcoal and pencil.

Portrait: The mystery of facial proportions will be explained in these four classes & will aid students in achieving likeness thereafter.

Green Sculpture (Teens/Adults)

Create a piece of artwork that helps to de-clutter your home while becoming a sculptural focal point. Suggested topics: animals or people.

I Can’t Draw But I Want to Learn (Adults)

In this 8-week class, solve this dilemma once and for all in a stress-free, positive environment. Drawing is fun and easy, once you take this class.

Multi-Dimensional Art (Teens/Adults)

This continuing class explores colorful expressionistic techniques in a variety of media.

Oil and Water (Teens/Adults) (Bob Noreika)

They might not mix, but both are essential! Spend 4 weeks with oils followed by 4 weeks with watercolor or fluid acrylics. Complete at least one painting with each. Some prior painting experience helpful, but class will accept students at all levels.

In each of these 4-week classes, paint a still life or a landscape.
