**Call for Office Hours****MISSION**

To help individuals of all ages achieve the skills necessary to draw realistically, and to teach the techniques necessary to gain confidence as an artist in other media, while encouraging creativity and independence.

**CURRICULUM NOTES**

- Minimum recommended age for *Pre-Kindergarten Drawing* classes is 4½ years old, but we will accept mature 4-year-olds.
- All *kindergarten* and *elementary-aged* students are required to take beginner and intermediate drawing classes as a prerequisite to all other classes. Skills learned in these foundation classes are essential to the Artsplace program:
  - **Beginner:** Includes contour line, flat color, texture, mirror image, negative space and volume drawing. Materials are Flair pens and markers.
  - **Intermediate I:** Reinforces beginner concepts with more detailed projects. (*Prerequisite: Beginner*)
  - **Intermediate II:** Introduces shading & volume drawing. (*Prerequisite: Intermediate I*)
  - **Advanced:** Includes perspective & introduces different media. (*Prerequisite: Intermediate II*)

Note: Sometimes classes are combined to facilitate scheduling; please contact us if you are unsure which class your child should take.

- *Teens and adults* are encouraged to take drawing classes as needed to ensure success in other media.
- *It is important that ALL STUDENTS, children and adults, attend the first session of a class to avoid missing critical information. If you will be late for or absent from any class, please call Artsplace so that your instructor is not waiting on you to begin instruction.*

**REGISTRATION & REFUND POLICIES**

- **Full payment must accompany registration forms. We can provide class information by telephone, but you are not enrolled in a class until payment is received. Please make sure that all appropriate registration and/or non-resident fees are included in your payment.**
- All classes/workshops have a minimum number of enrollees needed for the course to run. If this minimum is not met, then the class will be cancelled. For this reason, it is important that you register for a class/workshop at least 2 weeks prior to the start date. Please list second and third choices for classes. If a class/workshop is cancelled, all registrants will be notified by telephone at least 3 days prior to the program start date.
- No news is good news! If you have not heard from us, you will be expected at class at the prescribed day and time. Please record this information on your calendar. If in doubt about the status of a class, please phone us.
- Unless otherwise noted, all **standard** supplies are included; students must provide any "**premium**" supplies desired (e.g., oversized canvases), "**personal choice**" items, or materials for more than 1-2 projects (e.g., wool for felting).
